Call To Order: Pearce

Approval of Minutes

1. <u>Regular Session: October 27, 2015</u>: Approved as amended. The minutes will be updated to reflect that Mr. Pearce called the October 27, 2015 Administration and Finance Committee meeting to order.

Adoption of Agenda: Adopted as amended. Items 7, <u>Decker Center Change Order #1</u> and 8, <u>Magistrates</u>, <u>Authorization of Negotiation of Purchase Contract for 144 O'Neil Ct and 4913</u> North Main St properties, were added to the agenda as action items.

Items for Action:

- <u>Council-Administrator Form of Government Training; Council Rule Amendment;</u> <u>Disciplinary Policy for Employees</u>: The Committee recommended that Council accept this as item as information. <u>CONSENT</u>
- 3. <u>Changes to Policy on Requiring Employees to Sign Documents</u>: The Committee deferred this item to the December 15, 2015 Committee meeting. Staff will provide the Committee with a copy of the County's disciplinary action form for their consideration.
- 4. <u>Council member Jackson's Motion Regarding Hourly Rates for Transportation Engineers</u> <u>and Part-time Interns:</u> Council deferred this item to a future Committee meeting. The County's Legal Department will review the language included in the Program Development Team contract as it relates to Exhibit E.
- 5. <u>Consulting and Representation Services Disaster Recovery RFP:</u> The Committee recommended that Council refer this item to the December 8, 2015 Council meeting for consideration as an Executive Session item.
- 6. <u>Richland County Sheriff's Department Victims of Crime Act Special Solicitation Grant;</u> <u>Equipment Only; 20% match:</u> The Committee recommended that Council approve the



request to accept the Victims of Crime Act-Special Solicitation grant, if awarded, to fund the purchase of equipment / supplies and training costs for the Richland County Sheriff's Department Victim Services Unit. The total amount of grant funding applied for is \$72,400, which includes a 20% grant match of \$14,480. **CONSENT**

- 7. <u>Decker Center Change Order #1:</u> The Committee recommended that Council approve the Decker Center Change Order #1 in the amount of \$54,507.
- 8. <u>Magistrates, Authorization of Negotiation of Purchase Contract for 144 O'Neil Ct and</u> <u>4913 North Main St properties:</u> The Committee forwarded this item to Council without a recommendation.
