# **Report of Actions**

- **APPROVAL OF MINUTES** The minutes of the February 28, 2006 meeting were approved as submitted.
- **ADOPTION OF AGENDA** A request to add an Ordinance Restructuring the Public Works Department to the agenda failed to receive unanimous consent. The agenda was adopted as submitted.

## **ITEMS FOR ACTION**

- **A.** Adoption of Fair Housing Resolution for 2006 The committee forwarded this item to the full Council with a recommendation to approve the resolution. The vote in favor was unanimous.
- B. Public Hearing and Resolution in Support of JEDA Bond Issue for Eau Claire **Cooperative Health Centers, Inc. (ECCHC)** – The committee forwarded this item to the full Council with the recommendation to approve. The vote in favor was unanimous. (This item will go before Council on April 18, 2006.)
- C. Ordinance Authorizing the Issuance and Sale of General Obligation Bonds to fund Improvements in the Olympia Neighborhood – The committee voted to keep this item in committee. Staff was requested to bring back more information on alternative funding sources. [Action Required: Administration, Budget]
- D. Ordinance Authorizing a Quit-Claim Deed to Hendricks Commercial Properties, LLC for a Certain Portion of an Abandoned Right-of-Way Known as **Oakdale Street** – The committee forwarded this item to the full Council with a recommendation in favor of giving first reading to the ordinance. The committee also recommended that Council consider reformulating the quit-claim deed policy. The vote in favor was unanimous.
